



Location Info: Reynolds Place SE3 8SX



Car Parking

Car Parking is usually available in Reynolds Place and local streets.

Reynolds Place is off Old Dover Road, near where it meets the A207 Shooters Hill Road. It is close by the Blackwall Tunnel Approach Road A102(M) and the A2 London to Dover



By Car

For a local map see the reverse of this sheet

From **Central London** follow the A2. After crossing Blackheath there is a large roundabout (A2/Blackwall Tunnel Approach). Take the second exit (straight on) which is the A207 Shooters Hill Road.

From **Blackwall Tunnel** (M11, A12, A13) take the third exit marked A2 Blackheath & Central London. Turn left at the roundabout on to the A207 Shooters Hill Road

From **M25 and Dartford Tunnel** follow A2 towards London. Go straight on at the traffic lights at the "Kidbrooke Interchange" and take the next exit (marked Central London). Turn right at the roundabout on to A207 Shooters Hill Road

From **Woolwich** take A205 South Circular to traffic lights at Shooters Hill. Turn right onto A207 Shooters Hill Road.

From **Bexleyheath & Welling** take the A207, Welling High Street, Bellegrave Road, Shooters Hill, Shooters Hill Road.

From **Eltham** take A208 to Well Hall roundabout, then second exit A205 South Circular to Woolwich. Turn left on to A207 Shooters Hill Road.

After passing "The Sun in the Sands" Pub and a Shell Petrol Station on the left, take a hard left into Old Dover Road. Reynolds Place is the first road on the right and the Boys' Brigade Hall is a few yards down on the right

After passing a block of shops on the left and the Baptist Church on the right (corner of Marlborough Lane), take next right into Old Dover Road. Reynolds Place is the first road on the right and the Boys' Brigade Hall is a few yards down on the right



By Rail

From *Charing Cross/Waterloo East/London Bridge, or Dartford via Woolwich*

From *Charing Cross/Waterloo East/London Bridge, or Dartford via Bexleyheath*

Alight at Westcombe Park

Exit through Station Main Entrance. Turn right into the Station Approach and then left into Humber Road. Turn right into Westcombe Hill and walk up the Hill. At the top of the hill go diagonally across the traffic circus (**Blackheath Standard**) and turn left into Old Dover Road. (Old Dover Road is the main shopping area, there is a Chinese Restaurant on the corner, and Marks & Spencers a little way up) Walk up Old Dover Road, the road crosses over a major road and then Reynolds Place is the fourth on the left. The Boys' Brigade Hall is a few yards down on the right. It is about a twenty minute walk. You could get a bus up the hill from the Station to the Standard. It is two stops.

Alight at Blackheath

Catch a bus just outside the station, on the same side of the road. Buses 54, 108 and 202 go to Blackheath Standard. Walk up Old Dover Road (see instructions under "Westcombe Park").

On Buses 89 and 178 ask for "**The Sun in the Sands**" Pub. When you alight walk up the road, the same way the bus is going, past a Shell Petrol Station. Old Dover Road is a fork to the left. Turn right into Reynolds Place and the Boys' Brigade Hall is a few yards down the road on the right. Total journey time from the station is about 15 minutes



By Bus

Buses 53, 54, 108, 202, 286, 380, 422 - alight at Blackheath Standard. Follow the directions from Blackheath Standard under **Westcombe Park Rail Station** on the reverse of this sheet

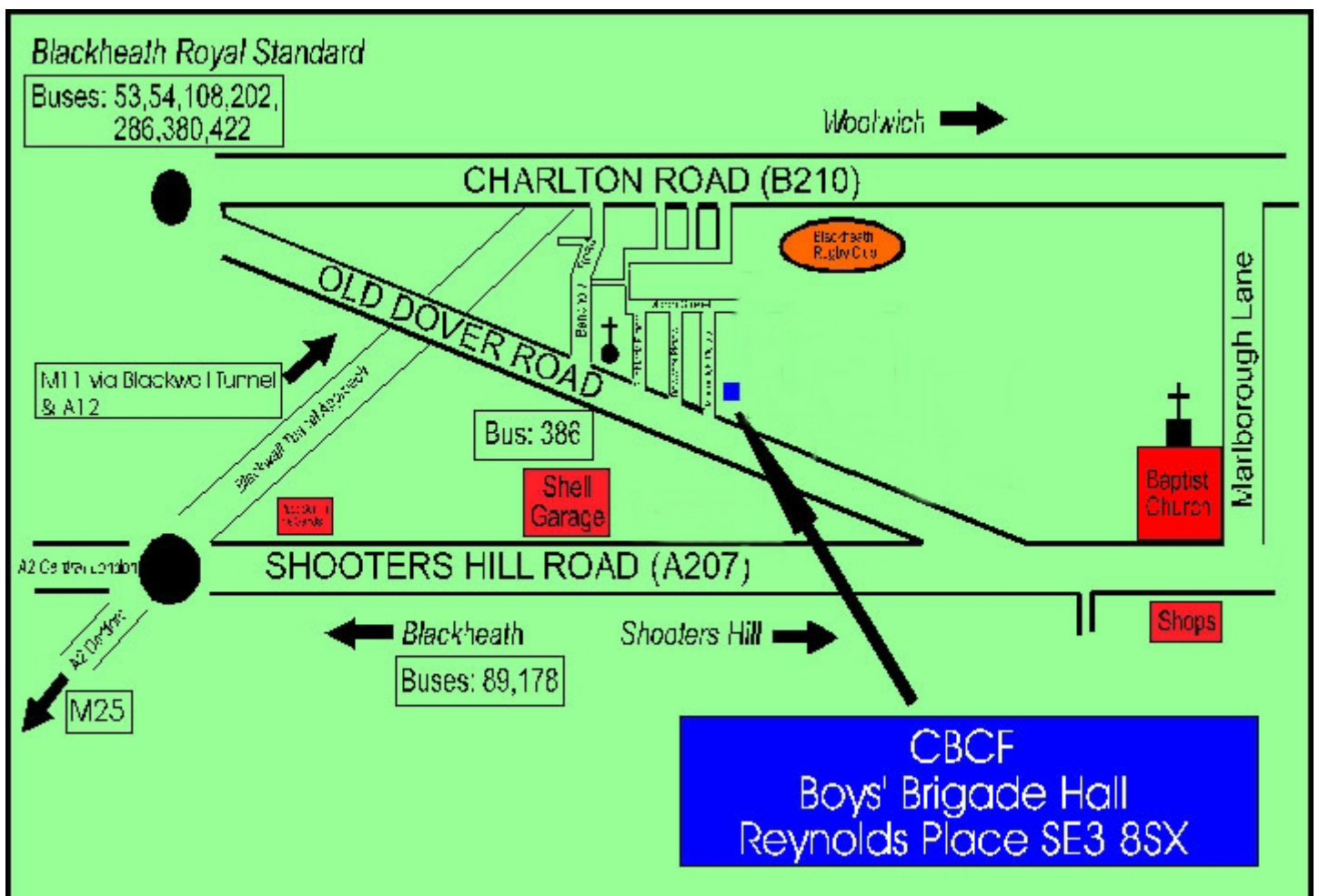
Buses 89, 178 from Blackheath and Lewisham - alight at **"The Sun in the Sands"** pub and follow directions on the reverse of the sheet under Blackheath Station.

Buses 89 from Welling and Bexleyheath and 178 from Woolwich, alight in Shooters Hill Road, near Old Dover Road. Cross over the road and go down Old Dover Road, turning right into Reynolds Place. The Boys' Brigade Hall is a few yards down on the right.



By Tube

Take the **Jubilee Line** to **North Greenwich**. Catch a Bus, either 108 or 422 to Blackheath Standard. Follow the directions from **Blackheath Standard** under **Westcombe Park Rail Station** on the reverse of this sheet
