Summon Your power, O God; show us Your strength, O God, as You have done before.

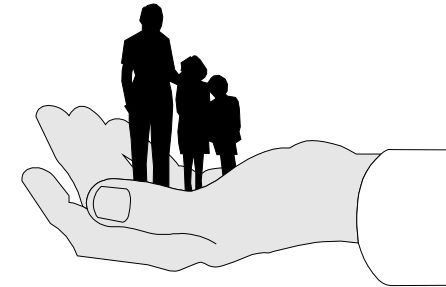
