### "The Bronze Snake..."

Mike's sermon last Sunday was based on Numbers 21: 1-9 and described the relevance of the bronze snake.

Among the points he made were the following:

- Moses didn't listen to God;
- He moved miraculously;
- The people were provoking God;
- But He is too powerful
- By now the first generation had died out;
- The new generation spoke against Moses;
- They were moving in unbelief;
- The snakes proved to be a hard lesson;
- They then saw the error of their ways;
- Moses continued to pray for the people;
- We should pray for those who are opposed to us;
- We need a forgiving attitude;
- The snake on the pole looked like a cross;
- Life is brought to the people via the snake.

Mike concluded by saying that Jesus dealt with the curse of sin; We should look to Him for salvation; We cannot earn salvation; We need to believe and trust in Him; We must not worship religious objects; We should have an attitude of forgiveness.
