"Born Again to a Living Hope..."

Mike's sermon last Sunday continued the series based on 1 Peter this time covering chapter 1 verses 3-12.

Among the points he made were the following:

- It was written at a time of persecution like now;
- Militant secularism is very common now;
- There is opposition against true Christianity;
- We stand on the Word of God;
- We are strangers and pilgrims in the land;
- The Trinity is a basic Christian doctrine;
- Mercy meaning unfailing love is a key word;
- We became believers through the almighty power of God;
- Hope is a certainty and will not disappoint;
- Living hope will carry us through difficult times;
- Life eternal begins when we are born again;
- Holding on to the joy of salvation will see us through trials;
- The Holy Spirit reveals truth to us.

Mike concluded by saying that this passage is all about salvation and salvation is our inheritance.
