# Introducing

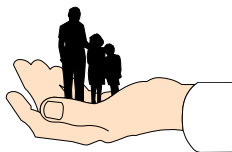
## Welcome to Charlton & Blackheath Christian Fellowship (CBCF)

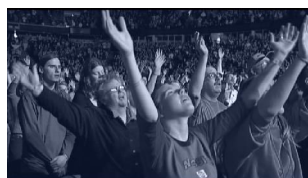
