Becoming a Christian is as simple as A B C

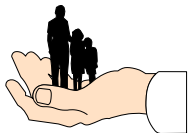
Acknowledge that we are sinners, who fall short of God's standards, and repent. This means turning away from our old attitudes and asking God to forgive us.
